WELCOME MESSAGE

Dear Colleagues,
Dear Friends,

It is a great honour for the City of Bologna to host the European Society of Thoracic Surgeons for its 16th European Conference on General Thoracic Surgery.

Every day, thoracic surgeons face the need to offer the best care for very complex and often severe diseases, with an appropriate use of resources, both human and economic. Open-minded confrontation among experts, wise evaluation of new information and the support of research: these are the ways in which Society promotes the scientific and professional progress of its members and the valid training of young thoracic surgeons in Europe.

Like most of our European cities and towns, Bologna is full of history and tradition. The original settlement developed along the Via Emilia as an Etruscan and later a Roman colony. Due to its Roman heritage, the central streets of Bologna, today largely pedestrianized, follow the grid pattern of the Roman settlement. The original Roman ramparts were supplanted by a high medieval system of fortifications, the remains of which are still visible, and finally by a third and final set of ramparts built in the 13th century, of which numerous sections survived. Over twenty medieval defensive towers, some of them leaning precariously, remain from the over two hundred that were constructed in the era preceding the security guaranteed by a unified civic government. Until the late 19th century, when a large-scale urban reconstruction project was undertaken, Bologna remained one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Europe; to this day it remains unique in its historic value. Despite having suffered considerable bombing damage in 1944, Bologna's historic centre, Europe's second largest (after Venice), contains a wealth of important Medieval, Renaissance and Baroque artistic monuments.

In the core of the down town area, the "Archiginnasio" is the place where the oldest University of the Western World was founded in the 11th century. On September 18, 1988 the rectors of 430 universities from all over the continents gathered in Bologna's Piazza Maggiore to validate the 'Magna Charta Universitatum Europaeum,' by which they marked the nine-hundredth anniversary of the University of Bologna and formally acknowledged it as the Alma Mater of all universities. The Magna Charta, which went on to be confirmed by another 400 rectors, reaffirms the autonomy of the university and the indissoluble bond between teaching and research, superseding "every geographic and political boundary." On June 19, 1999 twenty-nine European ministers of higher education met in the 'Aula Magna' of the university to confirm the so-called 'Declaration of Bologna', which laid out the principle objectives for higher education in the European area, and considered ways of promoting the European model throughout the world and increasing its competitiveness.

Bologna will embrace you with its tradition of culture and good living in an "on foot"-meeting. When you arrive at your hotel, the congress venue, the event's sites, artistic monuments, museums, shops or restaurants, the beating heart of the city will all be just a short walking distance. It is lovely to stroll under the porticoes that wind for about 40 km in and around the city centre!

The ESTS welcomes you to Bologna and hopes the meeting will prove profitable for you. We also wish you a pleasant stay in the city.

GENERAL INFORMATION ON BOLOGNA

Bologna is the regional capital of Emilia Romagna, and a compulsory point of passage between the North and South of the Peninsula: Located in the heart of Italy, Bologna is undoubtedly among the most beautiful cities in Italy.

In the charming historical center, among the best preserved in the world, many ancient palaces and churches stand and witness the cultural relevance that Bologna has had in the course of the centuries. A most modern Fair District, an efficient Congress Palace, up-to-date welcome structures crown a rich group of industrial companies of primary importance in the mechanical sector and in the field of agricultural and food processing, etc. Just taking a walk along the nearly 40 kilometers of porticoes that decorate its streets allows you to catch aspects of a life full of moods, to follow shopping itineraries in glamorous boutiques or in large and small street markets, also for food, to know a many-sided reality, culturally and economically at home in XXI century Europe. Bologna is art, culture, tradition, museums, villas, streets, palazzos, piazzas, churches, abbeys, fortifications and towers. But it is also theatres, cinemas, discotheques, nightclubs, favourite hang-outs, parties and shopping. The Bologna of learning and knowledge, famous for the oldest University in the world, the Alma Mater Studiorum, merges with the Bologna of hearty flavours, the one that has been justly designated the "capital of gastronomy". In the heart of the city, by the main square, you can find the old market with fruit and vegetable stands, bakeries, delicatessens, fishmongers and pasta shops where tagliatelle and tortellini are made. You can try this pasta in traditional restaurants and trattorias.

The different historical periods can be explored in the city and its many museums.

Bologna can also boast a great musical heritage. The Teatro Comunale, the opera-house, designed by Antonio Bibiena, is one of the oldest opera-theatres in the world. In the 18th century, Bologna was the temple of music in Europe. Mozart came here to sit the exam for the admission to the Philharmonic Academy. The great composer Rossini studied and lived in Bologna.

In the Bologna area, world famous gems of the motor and sports car industry are manufactured, such as Ducati, Maserati, Ferrari and Lamborghini. Fans of racing cars and the motor industry can visit these factories and their fascinating motor museums.

TRAVEL TO BOLOGNA

With its intercontinental airport "Guglielmo Marconi" and a privileged position, major node on the railway and traffic network, Bologna is strategically located and can be easily reached from other cities in Italy and abroad. The recent renovation works at Bologna airport allow connections with major destinations all over the world.

BY AIRPLANE :

The Bologna "Guglielmo Marconi" Airport (www.bologna-airport.it) is at about 13 km from the city centre. You can reach the city in approx. 20 minutes by taxi (+/- € 20.00) or by bus (Aerobus - BLQ shuttle service to the central-railway station; +/- € 5.00 one way) (www.atc.bo.it).

BY BUS OR TRAIN :

The Palazzo Re Enzo is situated only 0,5 km from the central railway station (www.bolognacentrale.it).

BY CAR :

Motorways coming from Milan and Florence (A1), Padua (A13), Ancona (A14): 3 km from Exit n. 7 on the Ring Road (www.autostrade.it).

WEATHER CONDITIONS IN BOLOGNA

Italy has a largely temperate climate with regional variations. In summer, the Northern parts of Italy are warm with occasional rainfall.

Temperatures in Bologna in June usually range between 23-27° C by day, nights are cooler.

ELECTRICITY

The main voltage in Bologna is 220V.

TIME

Bologna is in the Central European Time Zone, one hour ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT).

SHOPPING

Typically, shops are open between 9:00 and 12:30. At 12:30 most of the shops close for three hours. At the same time, the streets of the city will empty because people tend to have an extensive lunch. At 15:30 most shops open again to remain open until 19:30. Exceptions to this rule do exist. Some supermarkets remain open throughout the day. Be aware that on Thursday afternoon and on Sunday, most shops in Bologna are closed. Some shops also close on Monday morning.

TIPPING

In Italy, service is usually included in the restaurant or bar bill, and additionally in most restaurants the so-called "coperto" (cover charge or service charge), which ranges from 1 to 3 euros, depending on the restaurant, is automatically added to the check. Tips are always welcome and usually 10 %.

PASSPORT AND VISA

Italy is a member of the European Union. Check passport and visa requirements in due time before your departure. Passport holders from countries in Western Europe (EU) as well as from North America, Canada and Australia do not need a visa to enter Italy.

Passports are no longer controlled once you have entered one of the countries belonging to the "Schengen" region.

All other nationalities need to contact the Italian Embassy in their specific country for detailed information. Letters of invitation required to meet administrative and legal regulations of some countries are issued upon request. In order to obtain your letter of invitation, please contact the congress organisers. Such letters should not be construed as a financial commitment on the part of the organisers.

Please note that in various countries, the visa application procedure can take up to several months. Therefore, an early application is recommended.




FLOORPLAN PALAZZO RE ENZO 1



Entrance and First Floor




FLOORPLAN PALAZZO RE ENZO 1



EXHIBITORS FLOOR PLAN






