Professor Peter Goldstraw



Professor Peter Goldstraw is a graduate of the University of Birmingham and a Fellow of the Royal College of England. He has held consultant posts at the Royal Brompton Hospital London and Professor of Thoracic Surgery at Imperial College London, UK. Peter Goldstraw is President of the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer, IASLC.

Professor Goldstraw was a founder member of ESTS and President of ESTS from 1994-1996 and sponsor of the Brompton Prize from 2000 until the present. He hosted the ESTS annual meeting in London 2000.

He received Honorary Membership from ESTS In 2007.

Professor Goldstraw has made an enormous contribution to thoracic surgery and has given over 380 lectures at national and international conferences. He has been awarded the Price Thomas Gold Medal from the Royal College of Surgeons of England in 2004, a Lifetime Achievement Award by the British Thoracic Oncology Group in 2006, the Merit Award of the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer (IASLC) in 2007 and a Lifetime Achievement Award by the Society for Cardiothoracic Surgery in Great Britain and Ireland in 2010.
