Contents of the course and practical skills stations:

- 5. Precision laser technology in lung tissue management and airway management
- 6. Chest wall reconstruction with plating systems and biological materials

The course will take place in 3 different rooms where delegates will be introduced into the technology through a 10 minute lecture followed by practical skills stations.

There will be 3 cycles of training in each group.

Delegates should pick up their vouchers at the booth of the relevant industry partners on Monday and Tuesday and be introduced to the new technology in preparation of the practical skills.

This is an ideal opportunity to get exposed-to several medical devices within a workshop.

Certificates of attendance will be issued upon completion of all skills stations.
